

We have been talking about what it means to be salt and light (Matthew 5:13-16)

- Call of being priests & kings (extending Christ's presence and rule in the world)
- To be a faithful witness to our culture—one that sees us as irrelevant and extreme
- Now = connect with our call to the nations

The command = Matthew 28:18-19a, NASB and Revelation 7:9, NLT = the fruit = God's plan

#### God is doing something new with Reality

- We've always been a **Sending Church** 
  - o College days = Get on fire and go
  - o Reality as a Sending Church:
    - Locally as sent-people
    - Strategically with church planting
    - Globally through missions (Reality has sent over 225 people to 44 different countries)

New = With Vision for Global Mission

Now, we are sensing a call to not just anywhere but to where very few (or no one else) is going

- o To reach the unreached (and in particular the least reached of the unreached... unengaged)
- We are beginning to have birthed in us the same call as the Apostle Paul
  - o Romans 15:20-21, NLT
- Why was this Paul's ambition? Because of how God has worked in Paul's heart
  - o Romans 9:1-4a, NASB
  - o Paul had a heart for the unreached
    - In this context the Jews = Paul would go to the Synagogue first, but in new places (Acts)
    - "Great sorrow and unceasing grief in my heart..." (v. 2)
      - God is moving us toward something like that... (like what? Who are the unreached?)

#### Who are the unreached? Or, what is a UPG?

- Not talking about anyone who has not heard the gospel (neighbor)
  - Largely a question of the possibility of hearing the gospel (or, access)
    - Not just poor, third world, primitive people in a jungle
    - Places like in Saudi Arabia, advanced cities with no body of Christ
  - o Almost 3 Billion people! (Cf. John 3:16)

- 17,000 people groups in the world

- 3,000 unengaged people groups in the world (UUPGs)

# Why do we care? Or, Why should we do something?

- (Great Commission + Revelation 7:9 + John 3:16 ) = God cares!!
  - o But we have always cared
    - In the last 10 years Reality has sent over 225 people to 44 different countries
  - o We find ourselves caring differently now, (or, strategically) and largely because of this:

This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached **in the whole world** as a testimony **to all the nations**, <u>and then the end will come.</u> –Jesus in Matthew 24:14

- Jesus has given us a task to finish
- So, how are we doing? What part of the task remains?

#### We are going to do something about it!

- My ambition has always been to preach the Gospel where the name of Christ has never been heard, rather than where a church has already been started by someone else. (Romans 15:20, NLT)
- This is what God is doing in us
  - We have always cared, but now, we are beginning to care with some missional clarity
    - We want to do something particular about it (finish the task)
    - We will no longer always just send in general—we will try to send in particular
    - In particular to where the name of Christ has never been heard
  - Our heart is that we want to make the greatest possible impact on the lost
  - All mission is good, but what is best? Lasting generational impact on the lost (obey Jesus)

### We want to participate in correcting the imbalance

- Only 3% of the world's Christian missionary force is going to UPGs
- 97% to the reached!!??

- Only 1% of all Christian giving is going to reaching UGPs
- That is just wrong
  - The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest. (Matthew 9:37-38, NASB)
- We are heading toward 100% of our (global) focus and resources going to reach the unreached
  - o We will honor current obligations... but be more focused in the future

### What are we doing to endeavor to be faithful as a sending church called to the unreached?

- 1. Communicating Jesus' Command and Connecting it with Reality's Global Vision
- 2. Developing a Cogent Strategy to Reach the Unreached and Unengaged
  - a. Resource Allocation
  - b. Partnership Development
  - c. Training in Long-Term Missions
  - d. Church Based Teams
- 3. Discovering the Call to People and Places in Particular
  - a. The Arab Gulf?
  - b. Indonesia?

# What does it mean to actually reach a people group?

- We do not speak of the task in terms of "every person", rather we speak of "A Church for Every People"
  - o "The Essential Missionary Task"
    - = To establish a viable indigenous church planting movement that carries the potential to renew whole extended families and transform whole societies<sup>2</sup>
  - o Viable indigenous church planting movements <sup>3</sup>
    - Viable = can grow on its own
    - Indigenous = comprised of locals
    - Movement = reproduces
  - o Importance = Only through these can whole people groups be evangelized
    - Pioneering is necessary where there is no local church that can evangelize its own
    - Someone has to come in from the outside to get that started
  - Reached = When a people group has a viable indigenous church planting movement capable of evangelizing their own people and working toward renewal in its own culture
    - A Clarification:
    - What we mean and do not mean by church planting among the unreached
      - This is what we do not mean (PHOTO 1)
      - This is what we do mean (PHOTO 2)

### A key strategy in starting church-planting movements involves small house or cell churches

- Cell churches are small gatherings (5 to 25 people) who meet in homes or public places
- Because these are small gatherings, they are more easily able to replicate and make the Gospel accessible across an entire community, thus starting a movement of the Gospel

# Church-planting amongst the unreached requires church-multiplication

Unlike church-planting in cities where there are already other existing churches... church-planting among the unreached requires a vision for church-multiplication since it is the sole witness to that community/society

This goal of starting church planting movements in all nations is within reach!

- We want to inspire, mobilize, obey, lead others to do the same
- We are not in this alone (though there are few...)
  - o **But there could be many: CHART 1** (Growth of Churches)

# We are living in a time of an unprecedented move of God among the lost!

- We a lot hear about the growth of: Terrorism, Islam, Secularism, and Consumerism...
  - o We hear a lot about how the church is not growing... (may be true here in America and Western Europe)
  - o More people have followed Christ in the last 100 years than in all of the previous centuries combined.

#### CHART 2 (Practicing Christians as a percentage of total world population since 1900)

- It took 18 centuries (1,800 years!) for practicing Christians to grow from 0% of the world's population to 2.5% in 1900
- Only 70 years to grow from 2.5% to 5% in 1970.....(double!)
- Just 40 years to grow from 5% to 12% by the year 2010......(more than double!)
  - o Today: There are more people alive today who call themselves Christians than in all of the previous generations put together.4
  - Today: There is 1 active Christian out of every 7 people in the world.<sup>5</sup> (A.D.100 = 1/360)<sup>6</sup>

#### WE LIVE IN AN UNPRECEDENTED MOMENT IN HISTORY!

- God is doing something extraordinary! The Matthew 24:14 task is within reach!
- God's Revelation 7 purpose of saving people is happening!

# And I want us to be a part of it... a whole people group?!?!

- 2 things about developing a heart for the unreached
  - o (1) Has be a **work of God** in us (pray!) and (2) Has to **take expression** through us (do something!)
- We won't all feel it the way that Paul did necessarily (Great sorrow and unceasing grief in my heart)
  - But there are those among us who do!!!
  - o The way we may feel it as a church is that we are eager to invest and send (senders and goers)
    - That may seem like a no brainer, but it is not
    - Not much of the church is really willing to do this (HARD PLACES; OPPOSITION)
