# One Year Bible

# Lord God, You are God; Your words are true.



**2 Samuel 7:28**

The times we live in are turbulent. The chaotic nature of our environment, society, and culture can shake a person's confidence. Often, it even undermines our sense of security. But the Bible lays out a different story: history is not unpredictable, it's being written by a sovereign God. The readings before you are a glimpse into that unfolding story.

In the Old Testament, you'll read from the Early Prophets. These authors recorded Israel's history through a tumultuous relationship with an allotment of land that God promised to give them. In Judges, Israel sinks to new levels of depravity, while Ruth lifts up our countenance--even in the darkness, light still flickers! The books of Samuel introduce several kings who attempt to bring justice to wild people. However, the human heart is so wicked that most of these leaders walk away from God, and lead the nation into exile, as seen in the books of Kings. Ezra and Nehemiah offer some reflection on their return from the exile, while Esther shows us that God is always faithful.

These historical narratives reveal our desperate need for a good king. One who will rule and reign in righteousness and truth. It is this King who we encounter in the Gospels. As you also read through portions of the New Testament, and make your way through the early chapters of Acts, you will see King Jesus inaugurate His kingdom.

Brothers and sisters, read these books of the Bible with the knowledge that God is sovereign over history. Even when leaders fail, nations war, and everything feels unstable, God is still in control. And if God is in control over history, there's nothing in your life that is too big for Him to handle. That's what God is saying to you in these passages. And you can find tremendous comfort in His promises!
